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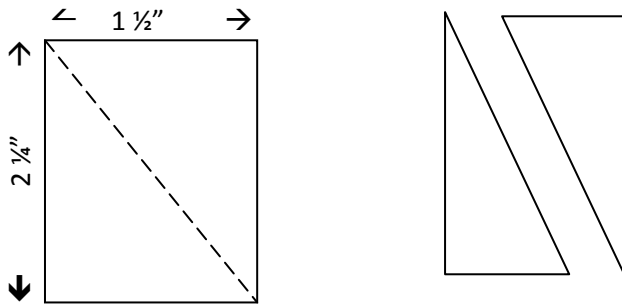
STICKLES Spinner Unit

Cutting Guide

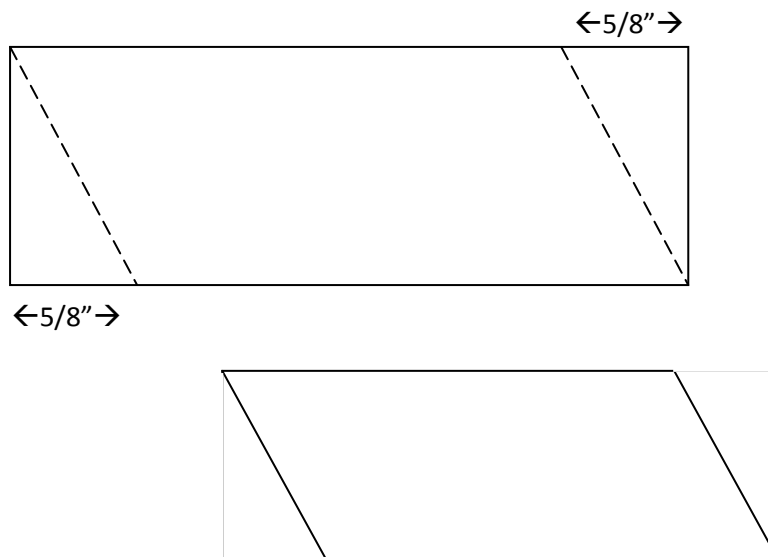
Chipboard

Casing: 1 @ 12"x7 5/8" (total of 4)

Base Ledge: 1 @ 2 1/4"x1 1/2" (cut in half to make 2 triangles) (total of 4 to make 8 triangles)



Ledges: 16 @ 3 1/4"x1" (cut to angle as shown below) (total of 64)



Shelves: 9 @ 2"x3 1/8" (total of 36)

Unit Covers: 2 @ 3 1/4"x2 1/4" (top and bottom of each separate unit) (total of 8)

Side Facings: 1 @ 2 1/4"x12" (total of 4)

Front Facing: 1 @ 3 1/8"x1 1/2" (covers open bottom section of units) (total of 4)

Top & Bottom: 2 @ 5 5/8"x5 5/8" (one for top & one for bottom) (total of 2)

STICKLES Spinner Unit

Cardstock

2 @ 12"x1" scored in half at ½" (these are to support the scored/sliced outer casings) (total of 8)

2 @ 3 ¼"x1" (for attaching the top and bottom individual unit covers) (total of 8)

4 @ 2 ¼"x1" (for attaching the top and bottom individual unit covers) (total of 16)

Optional Box on Top of Unit

Chipboard Cutting guide

1 @ 5"x5"

4 @ 1 ½" x5"

Cardstock Cutting Guide

4 @ 5"x1"

4 @ 1 ½"x1"
